

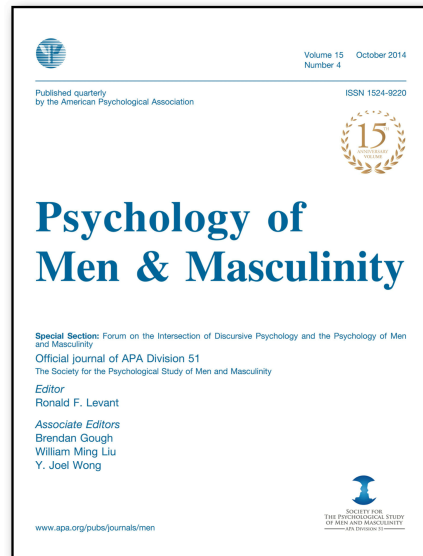

# Impact Factor Formula



$$\text{2013 Impact Factor} = \frac{\text{Number of citations to 2012 publications} + \text{Number of citations to 2011 publications}}{\text{Number of citable articles published in 2012} + \text{Number of citable articles published in 2011}}$$

$$1.823 = \frac{46 + 67}{31 + 31}$$

Online Supplemental Figure S1. Journal Impact Factor (IF) formula and calculation of the *Psychology of Men & Masculinity*'s 2013 IF. The denominator of the formula consist of only "citable articles" or primary articles (including regular articles, brief reports, and theoretical/review papers). However, any citations given to ancillary publications (e.g., editorials, commentaries, and corrections) factor into the numerator.
