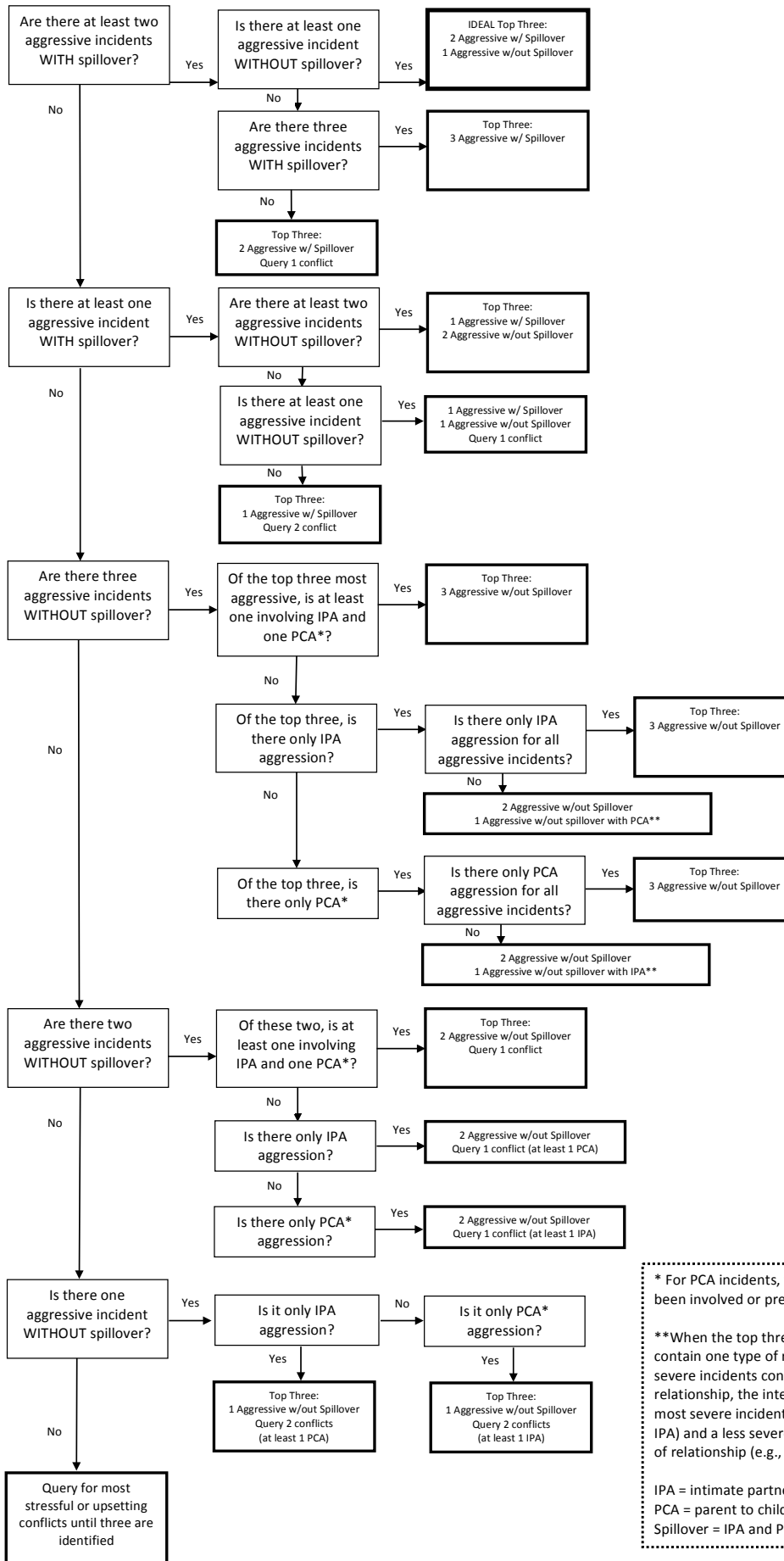


CIRCLE Interview Severe Incidents Selection Decision Tree

Top three incidents/conflicts should always be the most aggressive (greatest number of behaviors) or the highest level of conflict, unless indicated otherwise.



* For PCA incidents, the reporting parent must have been involved or present during the incident.

**When the top three aggressive incidents only contain one type of relationship (IPA or PCA) but less severe incidents contain the other type of relationship, the interviewer will use the top two most severe incidents regardless of relationship (e.g., IPA) and a less severe incident with the missing type of relationship (e.g., PCA).

IPA = intimate partner aggression

PCA = parent to child aggression

Spillover = IPA and PCA in same incident
