Background Information to Establish Presence or Absence of ID	
Non-ID condition: Alex is 19 years old and the youngest of 4 children. When he was 10 years old, he received a psychological evaluation and had a WISC IQ score of 108. His scores on adaptive behavior measures were also in the average range. His high school curriculum consisted mostly of vocational classes in which he earned passing grades. He graduated high school at age 18.	ID condition: Alex is 19 years old and the youngest of 4 children. When he was 10 years old, he received a psychological evaluation and had a WISC IQ score of 62. His scores on adaptive behavior measures also indicated significant deficits. He attended special education classes throughout his school career and left high school at age 18 with a certificate of attendance.
Presentation of Mental Health Symptoms	
Text Vignette: About 6 months ago, Alex's parents noticed that he had begun spending much of his time sitting and staring blankly. He does this for hours at a time whether in the company of others or alone. He rarely expresses his emotions, though at times he is seen smiling and laughing, or muttering to himself. Typically, the content of these mutterings is, "Bad boy," or "Alex, stop doing that... I told you not to do that." For the last 6 months, Alex has been bathing very infrequently and pays little attention to matters of personal hygiene. He wears several layers of clothing irrespective of the weather and is often seen stuffing food into his pockets. Last month, he started storing food in his bedroom closet and under his bed which is an annoyance to his parents. Alex started talking a lot about God and thinks God will punish people who don't save food. Around this same time, Alex was fired from a job as a bus boy when the manager found that he was bothering patrons. Upon looking into the matter, his parents discovered that Alex had been telling diners that they should finish all their food and not be wasteful.
