

Supplemental Materials

Internal consistencies of many of the EPA subscales in this sample were low, which appeared to be driven by reverse-scored items in the scales. This raises possible questions about the precision of the results. We addressed this in a series of supplemental analyses in which we calculated each EPA subscale without reverse-scored items (all of which had higher internal consistencies: $\alpha_{\text{mean}} = .76$, range: .56 - .86) and re-ran all of our analyses using the same methods as the primary analyses (e.g., hierarchical PCA, Bayesian regressions).

In many ways, the hierarchical structure of psychopathy with the recalculated EPA subscales resembled that in the primary analysis, specifically in that the unfolding of the top five echelons were virtually identical (see Figure S1). However, after the fifth echelon, component solutions became diffuse and non-specific (see Table S3). We nevertheless continued to extract component solutions from 6 and 7 and used them in a series of regression models, the same 8 models per form of regression (all of which converged unproblematically). Results of these models resembled those in our primary analysis in many ways. First, optimal solutions included either 5 (physical and social aggression) or 6 (rule breaking) dimensions of psychopathy (see Table S4). Second, in each of these models, predictors accounted for a large amount of variance in predicting aggression, with male sex and callous manipulation being the primary predictors. In contrast to the primary analyses, fearless dominance was associated with physical aggression and rule breaking behavior, unconcern was associated with social aggression and rule breaking behavior, and diffuse factor (the highest loading of which were narcissism, Machiavellianism, and manipulation) was associated with rule breaking behavior. However, in all cases these effects were modest in size. Results of our supplemental analyses thus broadly accord with those of the primary analyses.

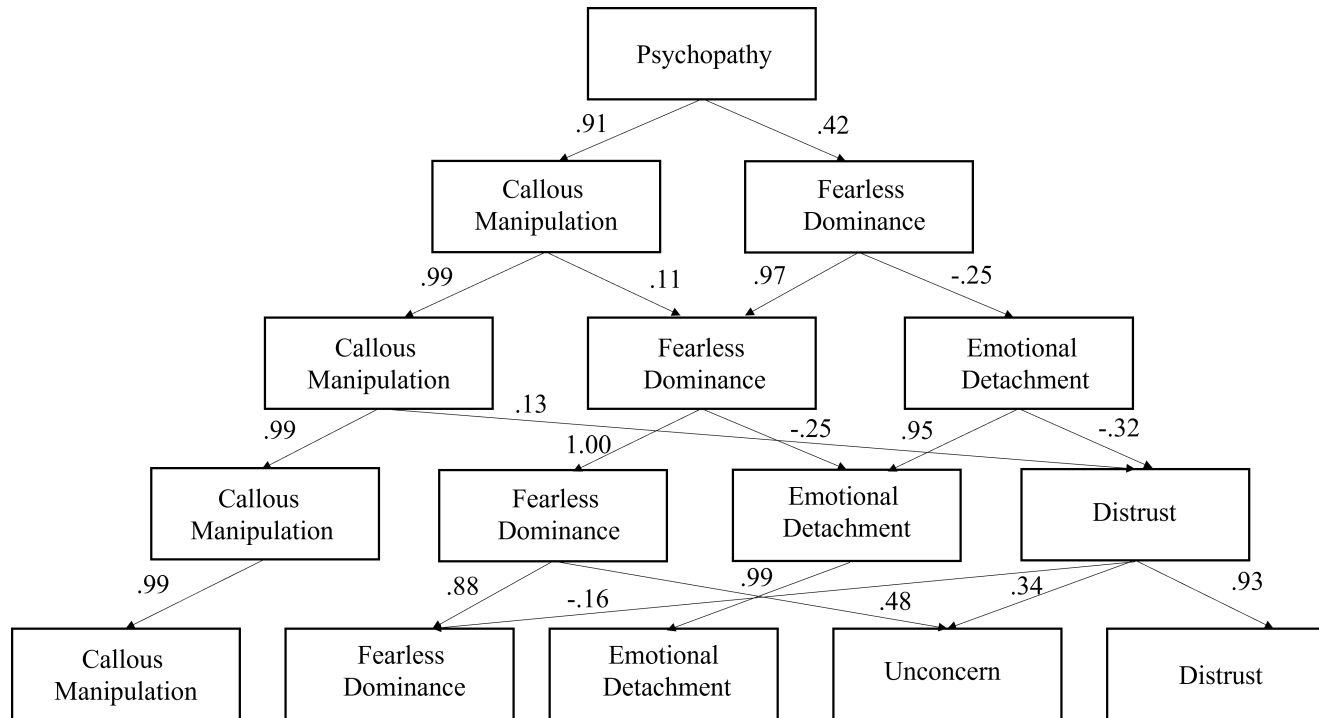
