


Figure S1. Determining the Optimal Number of Factors to Represent the Models of Facial Expressions of Emotion Across Cultures. To identify the optimal number of factors to represent the models of facial expressions of emotion across cultures, we proceeded in three steps. First, we pooled the 25 Western Caucasian and 37 East Asian models of facial expressions of emotion (each represented as a 1 X 42-dimensional vector detailing the coefficients of each AU's positive correlation with the categorization responses), resulting in a matrix (i.e., 62 facial expressions X 42 AUs) of real values. To this matrix, we then applied Non-Negative Matrix Factorization (NMF) in an iterative manner (k = 2 to 20 factors, 1000 replicates per iteration), computed the variance explained at each iteration, and identified the minimum of the curve using the second derivate (Cattell, 1966). Our analysis revealed that four factors best represent the pooled Western Caucasian and East Asian models of facial expressions of emotion.




Figure S2. Determining the Optimal Number of Clusters to Represent Facial

Expressions of Emotion According to Valence, Arousal, and Dominance. To identify the optimal number of clusters to represent facial expressions of emotion according to valence, arousal and dominance, we proceeded as follows. First, we extracted the average ratings of valence, arousal, and dominance for each emotion word a culturally valid facial expression model (i.e., d-prime > 1; see Method - Valence, arousal, and dominance of emotion words in each language), thereby producing a 62 (emotion words) X 3 (valence, arousal, dominance) matrix of real values ranging from 1 (lowest rating) to 9 (highest rating). We then applied to this matrix a k-means cluster analysis in an iterative manner (k = 2 to 10 clusters, 1000 replicates per iteration), computed the total within-cluster point-to-centroid distances (squared Euclidean distance) at each iteration, and identified the maximum of the curve using

the second derivate (Cattell, 1966). Our analysis revealed that three clusters best represent the data, with each cluster representing specific ratings of valence, arousal, and dominance.


