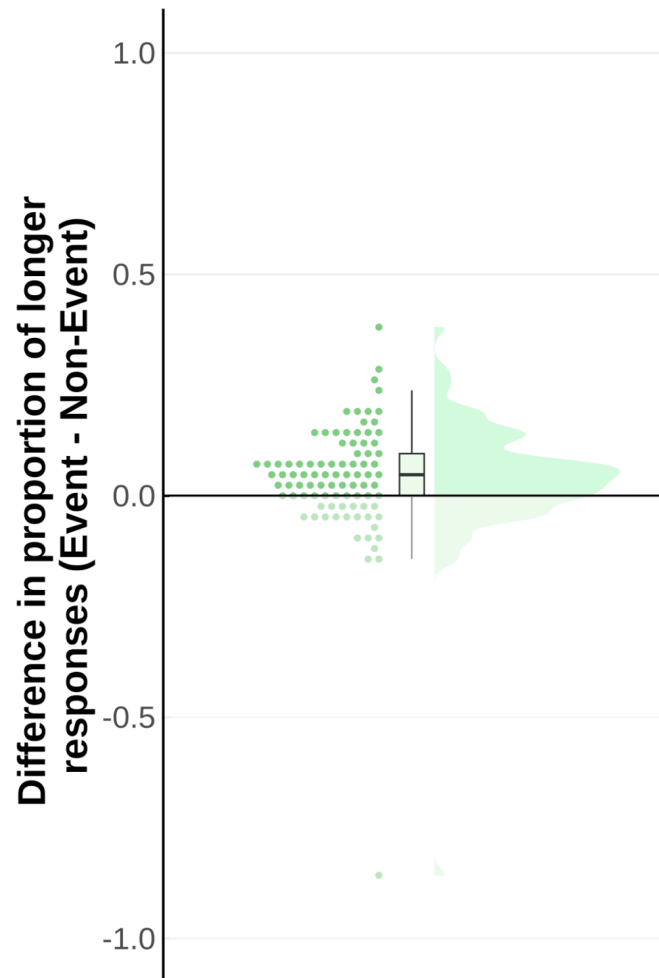


Fig. S1. Experiment 2 results broken down by individual subject. Plotted here is the difference in the proportion of “longer” responses for Event trials than for Non-Event trials; a greater difference indicates a stronger effect in the predicted direction.

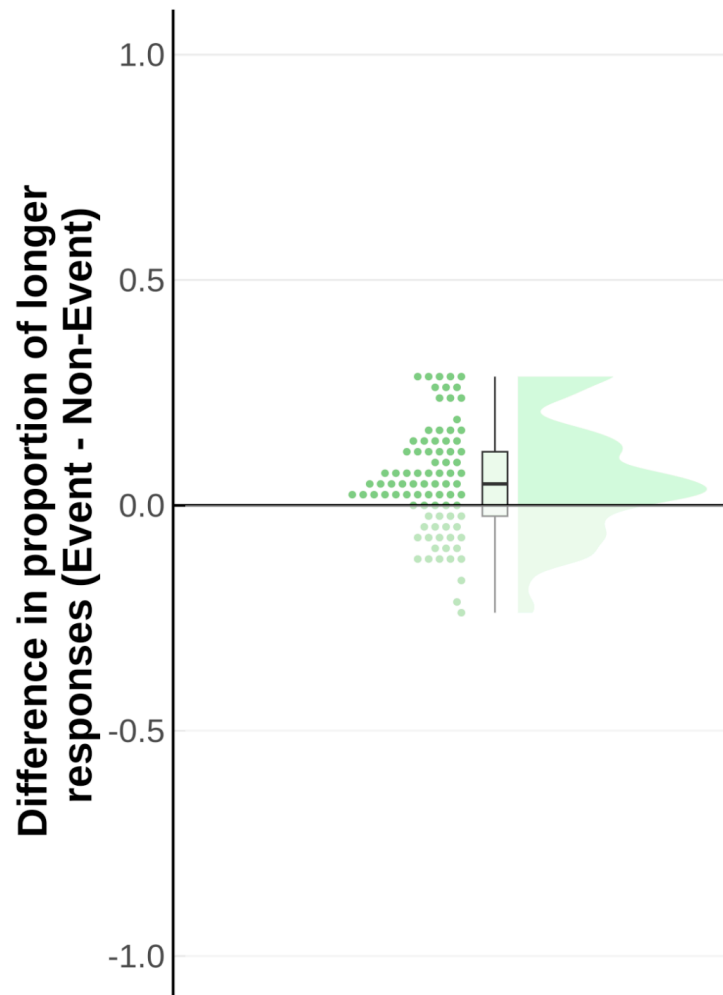


Fig. S2. Experiment 3 results broken down by individual subject. Plotted here is the difference in the proportion of “longer” responses for Event trials than for Non-Event trials; a greater difference indicates a stronger effect in the predicted direction.

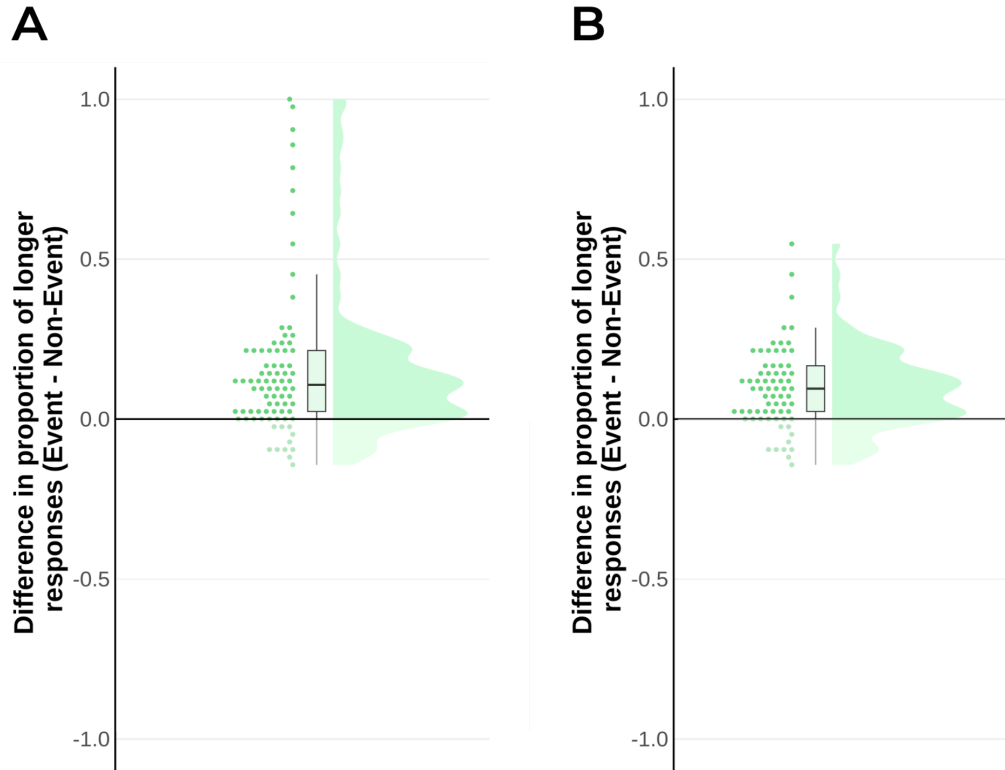


Fig. S3. Experiment 4 results broken down by individual subject. Both panels plot the difference in the proportion of “longer” responses for Event trials than for Non-Event trials; a greater difference indicates a stronger effect in the predicted direction. **(A)** Results after excluding subjects based on pre-registered exclusion criteria. **(B)** Results after additionally excluding subjects with an overall accuracy lower than 0.6 (this was done because we observed a non-negligible number of subjects with accuracy near chance).
