Transition Oncology Program (TOP)

- Physician referral to TOP
- Psychology consultation
- Targeted neurocognitive assessment for those not receiving research protocolbased assessment
- Provide ongoing guidance and advocacy support to caregivers and community school regarding educational processes through interagency collaboration

- All new oncology patients referred
- Comprehensive educational assessment to inform planning
- Educational consultation
- Initial interagency contact
- Coordinate in the creation of IEP/504 plans, if applicable

School Program

- Ongoing interagency contact and collaboration
- Consult regarding implementation of IEP/504 plans, if applicable
- Systematic assessment of educational risk with upcoming transition (e.g., administration of the BSNI)
- Results inform level of school advocacy coordinator support
- Facilitate transition back to community school through interagency collaboration
